# City of Regina Lead Services Program

The City's Lead Service Connection Management Program (LSCMP) provides residents with support to effectively reduce the potential for lead in tap water. The program is for residents who have a lead water service connection or have higher lead levels than Health Canada's maximum acceptable concentration. 1.58% of households in the Rosemont Mount Royal area have a lead connection.

Each year, the City mails out notification letters to all homeowners and tenants living at properties with known City-owned lead service connections, to notify and provide information about the LSCMP.

In April 2021, City Council approved the change from a one-time water filter to an annual water filter program for residents effected by lead water service connections.

Visit Regina.ca/leadservice to learn more about where lead service connections exist in the city and steps to reduce exposure to lead in drinking water.
