The RMRCA is pleased to again offer a Community Waste Drop-off Depot on Saturday, September 23rd at Martin Collegiate parking lot. Residents of the Rosemont and Mount Royal communities can bring accepted items to the depot during this event.

Items accepted: (MUST be separated by category)

- General yard waste (must be in paper yard bags or loose)
- Trees, branches (we will have a wood chipper available on site)
- General household waste
- Recyclables (paper, plastic, cardboard, etc.)
- Scrap metal (Freon, gas, & oil free items only)
- -Refundable beverage containers (SARCAN)

Items not accepted:

- Hazardous waste & containers
- Tires
- Building materials (bricks, drywall, etc.)

If your items are not accepted, please visit Regina.ca/waste and use the Waste Wizard to determine where your items can be disposed of safely.



Residents can drop off refundable beverage containers (SARCAN) during the event - all proceeds will be split evenly between Walker SCC & Rosemont SCC for school yard equipment upgrades and Martin Collegiate for their upcoming band trip.

Paper yard waste bags will be available for pickup.


