RMRCA Student Volunteer Scholarships

Two scholarships are available in the amount of \$1,000 each! Students living in the Rosemont Mount Royal community can submit their résumés in writing by May 31st, 2026 for a chance to be awarded one of the two scholarships in June.

To apply, simply submit your cover letter and résumé which includes your name, mailing address, email address and the Institution that you will be attending for the 2026/2027 school year. Résumé must outline your volunteer history as well as any current community involvement that you participate in. Résumé must also include the name and contact information of at least two (2) references that can verify your volunteer involvement.



Scholarships are intended to assist students with post-secondary education costs. Payment of scholarship will be remitted upon proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution.

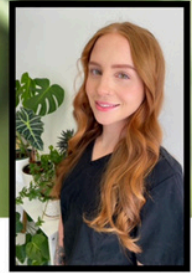
